1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The Board of Trustees of Laramie County Community College (LCCC) is committed to ensuring effective decision making in all realms of the institution including information technology. In regards to organizational decision making, the Board is further vested in the active involvement of all internal college constituencies through an ongoing participative process of shared governance.

The purpose of this policy is to promote and maintain LCCC’s information technology services in a manner that leads to student success and to efficient and effective operations in support of the College’s mission. This policy aligns with the Board’s commitment to sustaining a culture of continuous quality improvement of the College’s programs, services and processes.



The President shall be responsible for implementing procedures to ensure the systematic utilization of information technology, based on shared governance principles, including technology planning, project prioritization and other administrative functions.
